Presidio County Requirements For Burning

WEATHER CONDITIONS:

- O Wind speed must be calm. Verify with local weather forecast.
- o Wind direction-smoke must not be a nuisance to adjacent land owners or become a hazard to road or highway traffic.
- o Relative humidity must be as high as possible. Limit burning to early morning or late evening.

Note: Final approval will be contingent upon conditions at time of burn. Weather conditions and the Texas Forest Service fire danger index will be taken into consideration before a final approval will be given for any specific day.

FIRE MANAGEMENT:

- o All adjacent combustible fuels must be removed for a distance of 30 feet minimum around area where burn is to take place.
- o Provisions for fire extinguishment must be on site in quantities adequate to control or extinguish fire if conditions change. An ample water source is preferred.
- o The fire must be continually monitored at all times during the burn.
- o The fire must be extinguished before leaving the burn area unmonitored.
- o The following agencies must be notified prior to ignition of burn.
