Presidio County generously supported the grant by paying the required 25% match on behalf of Preventative Care Health Services (PCHS). Following closeout of the grant, Presidio County is due a refund of unused match funds in the amount of \$115,144.08. The funds will be used to support the Presidio Rural Health Center, a new 6,500 sq. ft. facility for which BBRHD will invest taxpayer funds to establish a permanent office, clinic, training space, and provider housing in Presidio County.
