

Expunction Procedures in Presidio County

In Presidio County, Justice of the Peace, Pct. #1, Justice of the Peace, Pct. #2 or the County Judge may magistrate. Therefore, you must include the correct magistrate in your application and order of expunction to ensure the person's arrest file is completely expunged. The following is a list of agencies normally involved in the expunction process. Please include the mailing address and email address of each agency in your petition if provided. Duplicate State agencies will not be notified.

This list is not all-inclusive and it is your responsibility to decide which agencies to notify. You should include any outside agency that has published your information concerning the charge/arrest. For each agency you include **that does not have an email address, you must pay the mailing fee or the certify mail fee**, which includes mailing of the notice and order.
